- To prove that nuclear energy can be an enduring benefit today and for generations to come, far into the future.



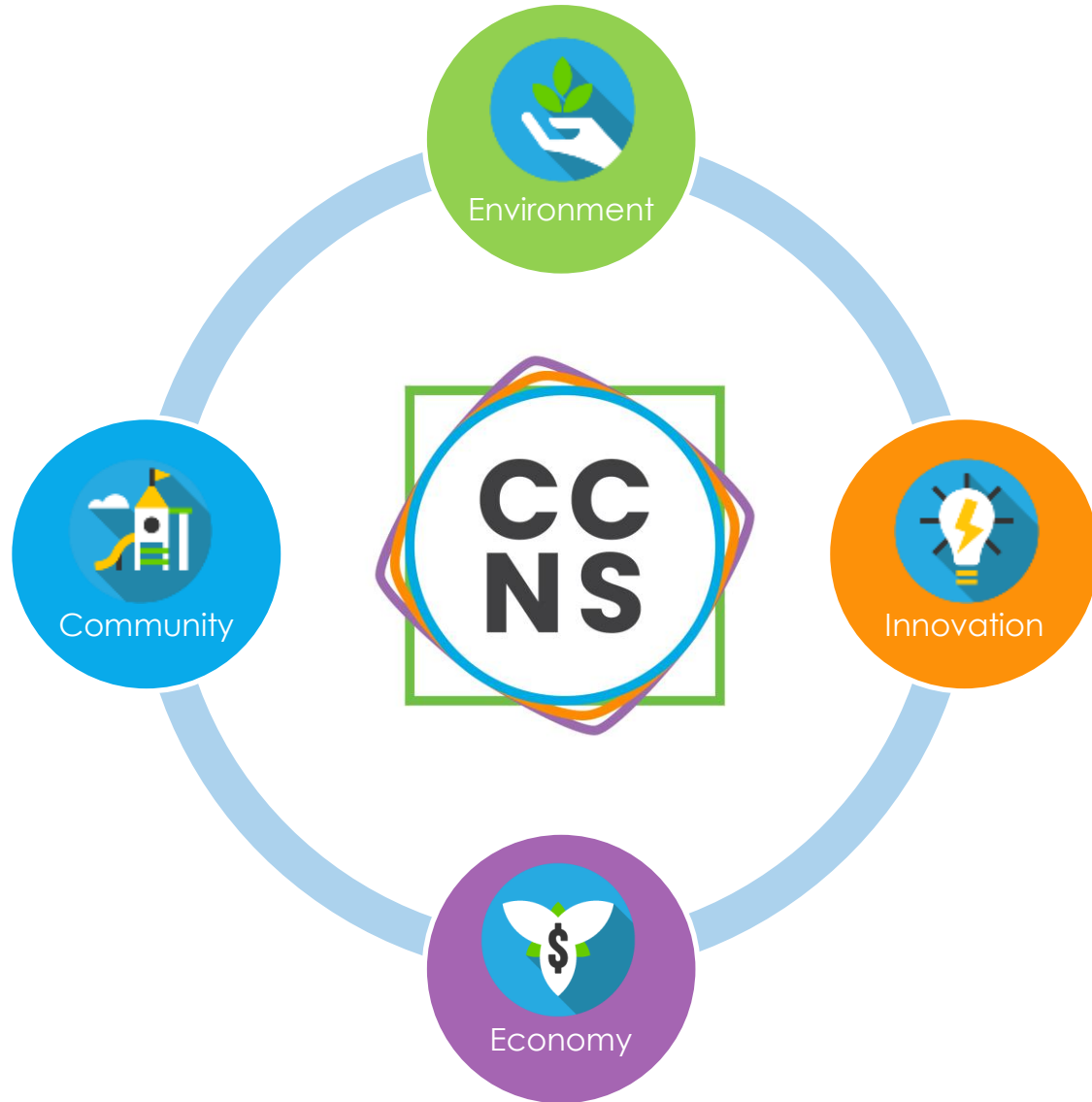

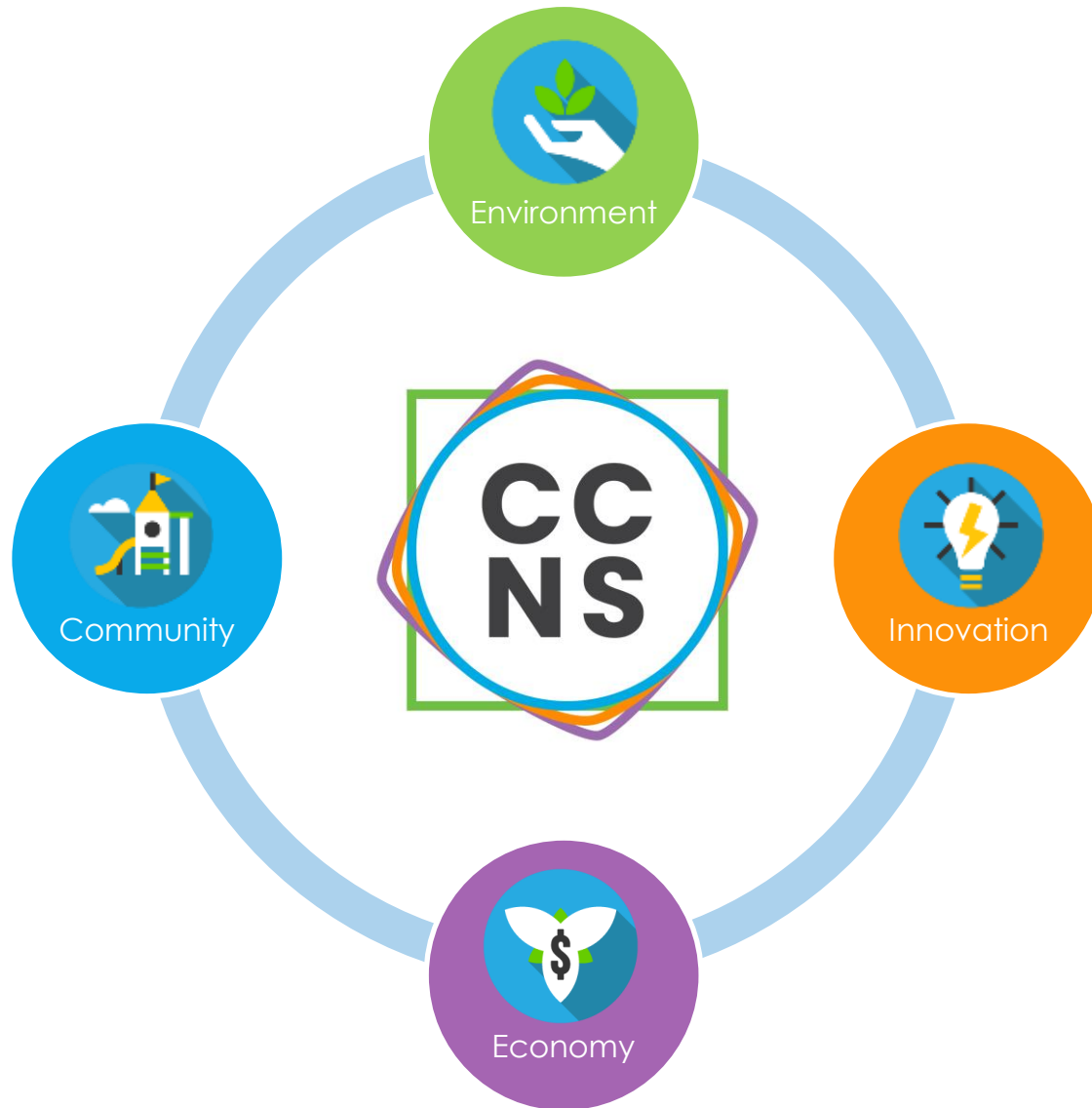

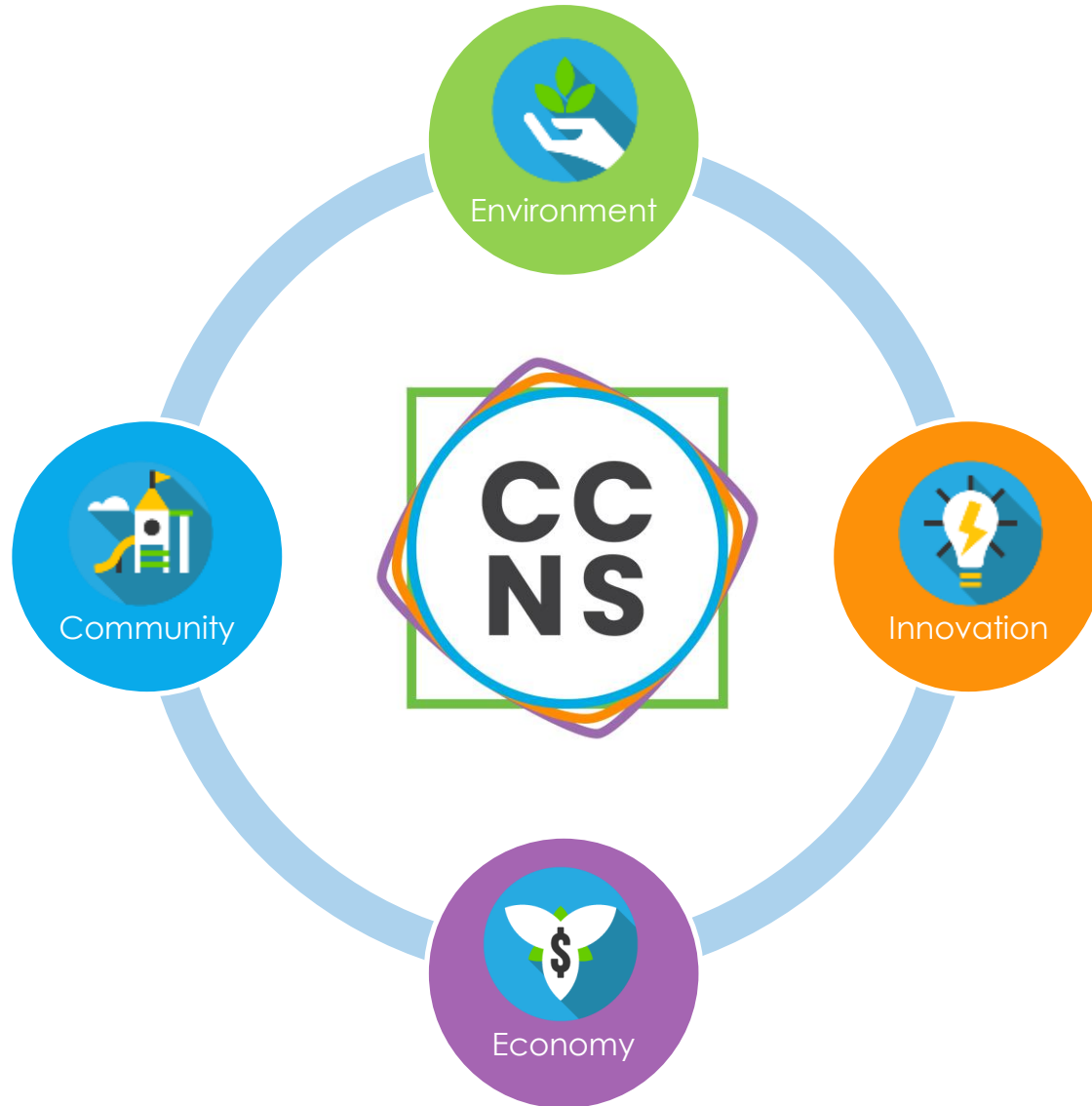
Innovation

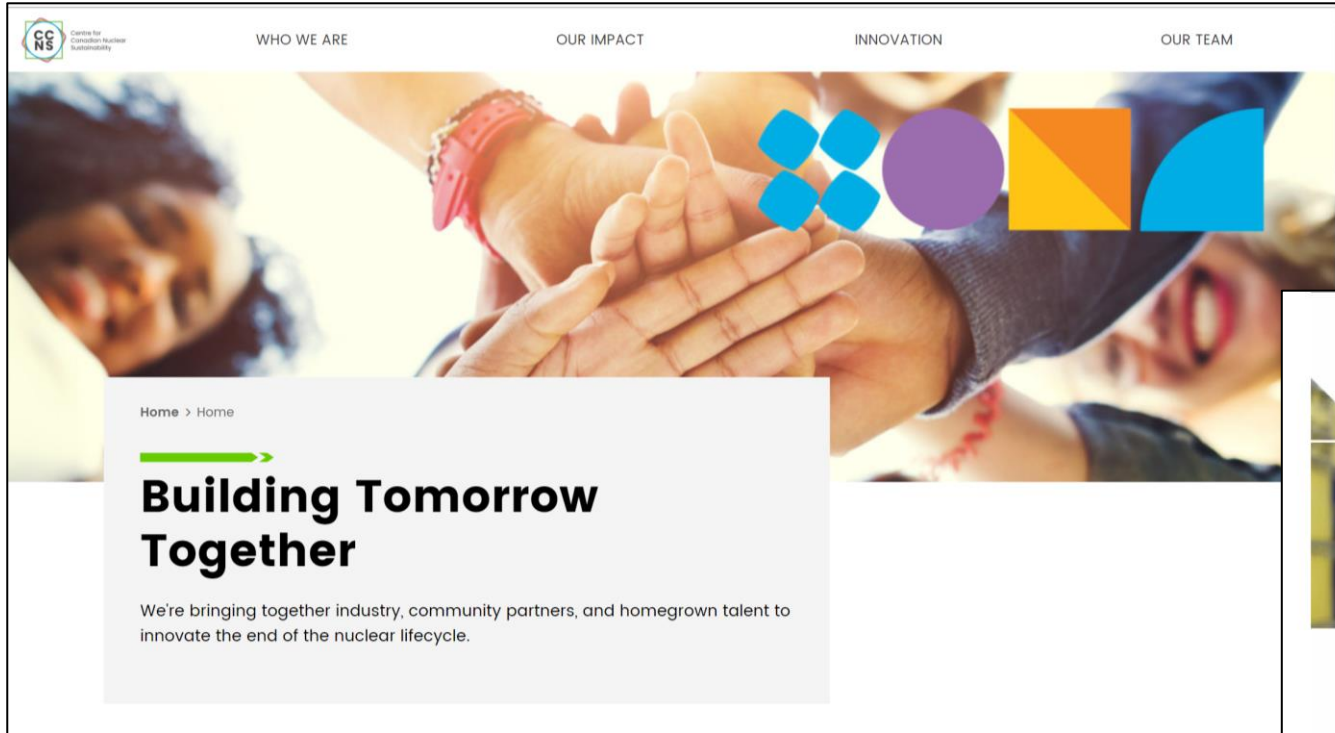
Community
